REPORT: B. Mancini reports that Board of Trustees is considering an operating budget for Task Force 2018 of \$1,500. Solar award of \$2,500 (2017) will roll into General Fund of Village for 2018. If funds are needed to support the April Earth Day Program, monies can be drawn from the \$2,500 award. Village will budget approximately \$20,000 for EVC only if \$16,000 of that is awarded via grant application.

ELECTRIC VEHICLE CHARGING STATION: Application is close to completion. Task Force will send application by April 15.Historic/Aesthetic Considerations - Application needs to reflect funding for design and installation of signage, hardscape, landscape, and design features to reflect historic setting. While a specific design plan need not be complete, flexible line item funding must appear in application. A. Leventon proposes a community design process be announced. After designs are submitted, Historic Preservation Committee needs to be involved. Final budget work will be completed by B. Mancini, advised by R. Reynolds before next meeting, April 10.
