Discussions	<p>M. Browne opens meeting to discuss the survey that has been circulated to the committee and reviewed. There are 24 questions to go over. #1 ranking the importance of the issues in the village; the committee agrees that this is a good one to start with and likes the structure of the question. #2-5 are all focused on the truck traffic problem on Route 9; the committee feels that four questions is a bit much and maybe consolidate into two questions and move them farther into the back of the survey. Also, possibly taking out the focus on Route 9 to see if any other areas of the village are thought to have traffic problems by the village residents. #6 speaks about the charm and character of the village and the committee agrees and likes the question but would move it to #2 due to its importance. #7 speaks about improvements in the village (sidewalks, roads, etc); committee all like this question. #8 Asking for volunteers, board agrees this is a good one to get to know what people are saying about volunteering on boards and in the village in general. #9 &amp; 10 are more detailed questions about volunteering so will take all three questions and consolidate into one question. #11 &amp; 12 are tax incentive questions; committee likes these questions. #13 asks about what residents feel is important to improve if we were to get additional funding like grants, etc.; committee likes this question but would like to see an additional question focused on the parking issue in the village if more businesses were to start to open. #14 what type of businesses are needs or desired in the village; committee likes question. #15 asks</p>

about tourist destination acceptance; committee likes this questions. #16 assesses satisfaction with village services; committee likes this question but wants to add garbage pick up to the list. #17 are more assessments on the village; all committee members like this. #18-23 are all geographic questions which the committee feels are important and will leave all as is. #24 is an open question and the entire committee likes this one to end with. M. Browne will review changes with Alan and Nan and come up with a final version of the survey to review at the next meeting.
