Minutes March 22, 2018 Budget Meeting

Mayor Dunham opened the budget meeting at 6:00 pm.

The village board entered the budget meeting with a total budget of \$1,214,304.44. The total tax assessed value of the village for the 2018/2019 fiscal year is \$146,646,220. The proposed amount to be raised by taxes is \$404,574.44 with a tax rate of \$2.75885 per thousand.

The village board reviewed the proposed expenses and expected revenues in the general fund and capital projects fund for the 2018/2019 fiscal year. The following changes were made:

Mayor Dunham is concerned with the estimated numbers for the William Street Project. He would like to speak with Hudson Valley Engineer. An estimation of \$830,000 for the entire project with a 20% contingency \$320,000 is estimated for the water lines. He is not sure the time table for applying and receiving grant funds for the water lines will be done and to complete the construction before winter.
